The two NT genealogies
Differences and similarities noted (see reverse side)
Possible explanation for the differences
1. Matthew represents Joseph's line; Luke represents Mary's line
2. Levirate marriage: Joseph's dad (Jacob/Heli)
3. Levirate marriage: David's sons Solomon and Nathan

# The Clear Purpose of Each Genealogy

Matthew writing for a Jewish audience Jesus as the fulfillment of the promise to Abraham (see Genesis 12:1-3) Jesus as the prophesied son of David who will rule forever (2 Samuel 7:13) Luke writing for a Gentile audience Jesus as the Son of Adam, the human for all human, the new Adam (see 1 Cor 15:45-49) "Son of Man" used 25x in Luke Jesus as the Son of God, fully divine, come to rescue the world

## Genealogies Yield an Insight About Identity, Humility, and Destiny

The absolute intricate unique particularity of every descended human Formed from one's whole genetic line, experiences, choices Utter uniqueness confers value (one of a kind) Utter uniqueness equals the playing field, resulting in humility Utter uniqueness shapes destiny: the unique contribution to the story of God Comparison with others is meaningless The only comparison that makes sense is to God's good created idea of me Jesus' strange statement: "why do you call me good?" in Luke 18:18-19 Seeing Jesus through a filter formed by a comparison with models of "goodness" Jesus rebuke: we can only be accurately described in relation to God's good idea of us
