

November 5, 2023 Consider the Lilies

Luke 12:13-34

Beware/be on your guard against greed: 15

Greed, the bully impulse for seeking more than you need, and its ubiquitous pull: 15

The antimatter of generosity: 21

Obsessing over the faster lane in congested traffic

Do not be anxious/afraid: 22,29,32

Which is better: hope disappointed or fear relieved?

The fact of the goodness of God as center

The misguided fear of falling out of view: Our Father knows we need such things: 30

Consider the ravens and the lilies: 24,27

Trusting in God's visible track record all around us

Are we deists at heart?

Christ holding all creation together: Colossians 1:17

Trusting in His heart toward you: "how much more": 24,28

Seek first His Kingdom instead of seeking food and drink: 29,31

It is good to be responsible: see Paul's admonition in 2 Thessalonians 3:10

Seeking in the sense of "being consumed with" (paired with "worry" in 29)

The kingdom of God: where God's way has its way

Prioritize (what you believe to be) God's way in the moment even if it puts at risk your stuff

These things will be added unto you: the principle of push/pull

Relationships, babies, promotions, break-throughs

Sell your possessions, give to the needy, invest in heaven: 33

An example of the "seek first the kingdom of God" principle

Instead of "self-first", this is an "others before me" model: see Philippians 2:3

Investing stuff either in a CD (certificate of deposit) or a DC (divine confluence)

Where your treasure is, there will be your heart: 34

Treasure: what you have actually accumulated and what you are accumulating

The best investment: accumulated actions of love

When it comes to stuff: Neither poverty nor riches: Proverbs 30:8-9
