



John 17:13-23

Seven Key Concepts Thus Far

- Koinonia (interwoven relationship) at the center of all reality
- The four dimensions of koinonia
- Cultivating koinonia with God as Father and King
- Worship of God through the lens of offering
- Guarding/deepening koinonia with God thru intentional practices
- The centerpiece practice: love one another as Jesus loved
- “One another love” always expands outward with centrifugal force
- The work of getting practical and intentional



We Turn the Corner Toward OUT

- High Priestly Prayer of Jesus: **17:13-23**
- The four dimensions of relationship in **21-23**
- The centrality of the prayer for oneness (love one another!): **11,21,22,23**
- A heart for the whole world
 - That they may believe and (implied) enter into the koinonia: **21**
 - The world may know you love **them** as much as you love Me: **23**
 - “World:” people, systems under the rule of the evil one: **12:31, 16:11; 1 Jn 5:19**
 - Sent out into the world just like Jesus was sent: **18; also 20:21**
 - Out of love (**3:16-17**) to be light (**1:9, 8:12, 9:5,12:46**)
 - In the world but not of the world: **14-18**
- Next week: the principle of **The Person of Peace (Nov10)**
- The following week: the principle of **The Beachhead (Nov 17)**

13 But now I am coming to you, and these things I speak in the world, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves. **14** I have given them your word, and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **15** I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one. **16** They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. **17** Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth. **18** As you sent me into the world, so I have sent them into the world. **19** And for their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be sanctified in truth.

20 “I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word,**21** that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. **22** The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, **23** I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.
